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IAM/AIR WISCONSIN NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE

Negotiations resumed on June 16, 17, and 18 at the maintenance facility in Milwaukee, Wisconsin with all members of both committees in attendance.

At this meeting, the Company and Union negotiated from their respective positions concerning economic items without any progress being achieved. Your Committee will continue to study the Company's economic proposals in hopes of finding any common ground. We will not trade your future for a promise.

Though the Company had previously requested the Union forgo the contractual obligation in the current Agreement, a 2% increase base increase scheduled for August 1, 2009, this increase will be paid in lieu of an Agreement in place.

We have been receiving good feedback from the membership during station visits. The committee asks that you keep voicing your concerns and keep the committee informed of any developments as they occur. Your feedback is essential in achieving a fair and equitable agreement.
