COMAIR PASS BENEFITS INFORMATION

Needless to say, everyone understands and shares the deep frustration of IAM members and other Comair employees concerning the pending changes to the pass policy. Your Union is exploring - and will pursue - all lawful means to avoid or stop this drastic change to our working conditions. Recently, the Company has made accusations that Comair employees may be instigating a “work slowdown,” “sickout,” or other job action in response to the changes to the pass policy. I have found no evidence or heard of any information that there is any such illegal activity actually occurring. The IAM does not sanction, endorse, condone, or support any statements or actions calling for such activity.

I do know there is a lot of anger and frustration regarding the changes to the pass policy. The IAM will use every avenue to fight DAL management’s change to the pass policy, and doing so within the provisions of the Collective Bargaining Agreement and the bounds of the law. To that end, I ask that each of you continue to conduct yourselves as the professionals you are and stay informed.
