IAM / AIR WISCONSIN NEGOTIATIONS MEDIATION UPDATE

Negotiations continued under the auspices of Mediator Victoria Gray on March 16, 17 and 18 in Chicago, Illinois. The atmosphere created by the Mediator was one of expected cooperation from both parties to bridge the gap on open issues. Some progress was made at this round of talks on the open non-economic issues with four additional Tentative Agreements reached in Articles 6 (Hours of Service), 8 (Field Service and Training) and 32 (Household Moving Allowance). While this is progress, the more difficult economic issues remain to be discussed.

The next scheduled meeting set for April 2010 was to occur in Washington, DC. Due to National Mediation Board scheduling difficulties, it has been moved and will now take place in Charlotte, North Carolina on April 12, 13 and 14. We will update the membership via bulletin at the conclusion of those meetings.

Please do not listen to rumors and always contact your committee members with questions. We appreciate your patience and look forward to bringing these negotiations to a successful conclusion with a fair and equitable agreement.
