IAM / AIR WISCONSIN NEGOTIATIONS AUGUST 2010 MEDIATION UPDATE

Negotiations continued this week on August 16, 17, 18 and 19 in Las Vegas, Nevada under the auspices of NMB Mediator Victoria Gray. The atmosphere in this round of negotiations was tense though the parties still remained cordial. Some progress was made at this round of talks with respect to growth provisions the Company insists it needs to grow the airline and secure additional flying. When looking forward to 2015 and beyond, the Union sees value in ensuring that Air Wisconsin remains viable. However, we do not see it at the expense of the current IAM members working under a profitable flying contract with mainline partner US Airways.

The next scheduled round of meetings is set for the week of September 20, 2010 in Burbank, California. We have also agreed to meeting dates during the week of October 18, 2010 at a location yet to be determined. Some of you may be asking yourselves why the meetings are in a multitude of strange locations. The answer to that question is that when the Company and Union request the help of the NMB, the Mediator dictates where the meetings will occur. Some are close to your stations, some are closer to where the Mediator lives and some are in Washington, DC at the NMB.

Get engaged with what is happening with your airline and communicate about the issues that are important to you as this helps the process. We appreciate your patience and look forward to bringing these negotiations to a successful conclusion with a fair and equitable agreement.
