MECHANICAL & RELATED NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE – 9/29/11

Your Negotiations Committee met with the Company September 28 and 29 in Charlotte, North Carolina; still a full three months before our contract becomes amendable. While the negotiating process is inherently slow we continue to make progress.

This session’s discussions centered around non-economic issues in; Article 6 - Overtime and Holidays; Article 7 - Travel Pay; Article 8 - Seniority; Article 9 - Filling of Vacancies; Article 10 - Leaves of Absence; Article 11 - Vacation with Pay; Article 12 - Sick Leave; Premiums and Bonuses, Article 13 - Transportation and Article 14 -Grievance Procedures.

A Planner Sub-Committee is being established and will report to the Negotiations Committee at the next set of negotiations in November. This Sub-Committee will consist of a Planner from PIT, CLT, and PHX and representatives from management. The Sub-Committee will be tasked with addressing issues specific to their work group.

Additional Accreded group Sub-Committees may be established as needed in the future to address their specific issues.

Also, Grievance Committee member Tom Belmont from PHL will join the Negotiations Committee as a full-time member at our next scheduled negotiations November 15 and 16 in Phoenix, Arizona.

Remember - Union Membership Pays - With your continued solidarity, we the Negotiations Committee are confident we will be able to negotiate an agreement that meets our member’s needs and assures them the protections of a Collective Bargaining Agreement they earned.
