IAM/COMAIR AIRLINES JANUARY 2012 MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

Negotiations were conducted this week with meetings occurring on January 10, 11 and 12 in CVG. Present for the Company was Jim Martin, Director of Maintenance Operations; Jay Stevens, CAMSF Manager and David Driscoll, Company Counsel. Present for the Union was James M. Samuel, General Chairman; Duncan Sprague, CVG Committeeman; Mike Belivanakis, CVG Committeeman and Mike Stadnik, BOS Committeeman.

The week was again dedicated to development and language passes for creating the much expanded Article concerning Reductions-in-Force, Leveling Bids and Station Closures. Much progress was made in drafting a simplified format to conduct all movements. There still remains a divide in positions on a few issues concerning this Article but we expect they will not hold up completing it in the near future.

As mentioned in past bulletins, we are at a point where few language issues remain, and economic areas of the Agreement will soon be the sole topic which would precipitate a filing for conducting negotiations under the auspices of the National Mediation Board. That filing will occur as soon as we are solely at an economic impasse.

It was communicated to your Negotiating Committee this week that APLA has tentatively agreed to changes to their health and dental benefits. The Company will be presenting us with a detailed look at their plan design at our next meeting. The dates for the next meetings are set for the week of February 27, 2012 and will occur in CVG.
