IAM / CommutAir Update

The Union has been receiving reports that the flight attendants are being told that they must move to the new domicile in EWR or face termination. The Union is monitoring the situation and will be addressing this issue in negotiations when we meet later this month. All of our IAM flight attendant agreements have sections entitled "System Furloughs, Base Reductions, and Base Closures". These sections spell out specific rules that must be followed when the Company enforces involuntary displacements to another base. Some of these rules address moving and relocation expenses and how seniority must be honored when displacing a flight attendant. Your Union is aggressively seeking many of these provisions for the CommutAir Flight Attendants, many of the same provisions most unionized flight attendants enjoy in the industry.

Our years of experience and expertise in negotiating industry leading flight attendant agreements will help pave the way to successfully negotiate a collective bargaining agreement that the flight attendants at CommutAir will overwhelmingly ratify.
