The company has made arrangements for recovery of the operation and has posted these on CCS and will be updating as necessary. The current CCS postings are as follows:

• In order to facilitate as efficient of a recovery as possible the company has secured hotel rooms in CLE, IAH, ORD, BNA and TYS. Crews that are unable to commute to EWR will be given the opportunity to make their way to one of the listed locations to resume their trips outside of the storm path. After coordination with the ALPA/ IAM, as recovery operations begin on Monday Aug 29th, crews will be pay protected (per their CBA) for their trips and not given commuter missed trips with the corresponding loss in pay. Any trip cancelled for this event will be pay protected per the CBA.

Trip Trades and Line Improvement will be suspended thru operational take down Aug 26th 14:30 to Aug 29th 12:00 CST. Any crewmember that has a pairing modification that contains deadhead/ RX flying, please be advised you are NOT released and that your schedule is in the modification process, you will be contacted via CCS and or a call from crew scheduling.

While the IAM was advised of Part 1 of 2, part 2 of 2 was not discussed with us and we did not agree to closing the LIW. Consequently, the following correction was posted:
